Much More Than A Case Manager

For those of us who have strong, intact family relationships, as well as solid lifelong friendships, this makes the journey of life easier. Mother Teresa always said, "Loneliness and the feeling of being unwanted is the most terrible poverty."

So many of the people we assist, come to view us as their "family." Kimberly is one such person. She recently shared with me that she found Journey To New Life and her reentry case manager Nick, following her 16 months in jail where she was facing a manslaughter charge. As she described, she spent 30 years deep into her drug addiction and paid a high price. She had no one she considered family. "The flesh is weak, but the mind is strong," she proclaimed to me. In jail, she finally decided she was done with that way of living. Fortunately, she was not convicted of the crime. Homeless upon her release, she was able to get into transitional living and met Nick shortly thereafter.

Kimberly, a lung cancer survivor proudly stated, "It's a good feeling to be me today." She proceeded to share all the ways Nick has been there for her. She shared she brings all her issues to him, and he has worked alongside her to tackle them – without judgment.

He helped her find low-income housing and continues to help her with her weekly budget, so she stays housed and keeps her basic needs

met.



Now, she said, she is a resource for directing others in need, and that purpose is gold to her.

EA SUPPORT: THE LAST 30 DAYS

EA, or Emergency Assistance, are the walk-in services we typically provide to folks coming out of prison and jail. These services cover things from IDs and birth certificates to clothing and shoes, and everything in between that a person needs to re-enter our society. They're often things that we overlook or take for granted ourselves.

The mass of donations that we receive, both monetary and item, usually go to our EA services as they fulfill the biggest need. Here is an overview of the need that our EA services have met in the last 30 days:

- \$1,160.87 to legal documents (IDs, birth certificates, etc)
- \$3,180.81 to medical expenses and hygiene products (soap, toothpaste, menstrual products, etc)
- \$39,858.34 to housing costs (deposits, rent, furniture, etc)
- \$2,649.50 to clothing, personal items, and work-related items



Overall, we spent \$54,226.28 assisting over 224 people in the past 30 days. That is a total of 224 adults, seniors, and children who have been helped through our EA services, their lives uplifted by the services that we are enabled to provide through the donations that you give.


