Did you provide clothing for those who needed it?

Did you visit with those in prison?

Journey to New Life answers "Yes" to all of these questions, thanks to our generous donors.

JTNL staff members travel to prisons to meet with people as they are developing their home plans. We operate two shelters for women recently released from prison, providing them with food, clothing, and acceptance, as each person is starting over. Those who come to Journey to New Life are virtually all strangers. And of course, we help many people coming back from prison through our emergency assistance, reentry case management, and employment programs. In April, 134 returning citizens were assisted with \$12,800 worth of basic essentials.

PROVIDING MORE THAN JUST BASIC NEEDS

Warren's needs were many. Upon his release from prison, all he had was the clothes on his back, as seen in this photo. Though currently staying at a halfway house, his needs included: clothing, identification, and assistance in finding a job. Journey to New Life was able to help him with all of these.

When asked what he needed the most, Warren said, "A second chance. I am not a bad person, I made a bad decision." Journey to New Life values affirming human dignity without distinction, so Warren was also provided with the acceptance and respect that he deserves.
